Agilyx, based in Tigard, Oregon, is the leader and pioneer in chemically recycling difficult-to-recycle post use plastic streams into high-value, low-carbon circular feedstocks and fuels. The company has developed and is commercially operating the first system capable of recycling post-use polystyrene into styrene monomer, which can then be used to remake new polystyrene products.

Agilyx has worked with The Gilman Brothers Company to test their unmodified INFINITY® Boards and determined that they are able to be recycled through the Agilyx's proprietary polystyrene chemical recycling solution. In this use case, Agilyx used its solutions platform to convert the polystyrene materials back to styrene monomer that is used to produce polystyrene for new products without any loss in performance, creating a circular supply chain. We continue to work with Gilman on the chemical recyclability of various inks, pigments, and dyes as well as labels adhesives used in conjunction with base plastic materials.

Agilyx is excited to work with The Gilman Brothers Company to enable their polystyrene-based products to be recycled.
